Opened in 1996 under the CT Supportive Housing Demonstration Program, Hudson View Commons houses 28 single adults and couples who are either homeless and disabled or low-income.

Located in Hartford, Hudson View is comprised of 19 one-bedroom units and 9 efficiency units. All units have a private kitchen and bath and are equipped with refrigerator, phone and cable jack already installed. In addition to the on-site laundry facility, residents have access to a recreational area, lounge, picnic area and public transportation.

All residents sign lease agreements with Broad Park Development and pay 30% of their income to rent. Supportive services are available but not required.

Opened in 1997 as part of the CT Supportive Housing Demonstration Program, Mary Seymour Place provides housing to 30 single men and women who are homeless or low-income.

Located in Hartford on the K bus line, Mary Seymour Place is comprised of 30 fully furnished one-bedroom units each with their own private kitchen and bath. The site offers laundry facilities, a library with computer, community room and a garden.

All tenants sign leases and pay 30% of their income to rent. Supportive services are available to all residents but participation is not required.

Opened in 1997, Cedar Hill provides 25 single men and women with a safe, affordable home. Cedar Hill is a mixed-population building with 50% of the units set aside for dually diagnosed (mental illness and substance abuse) persons, 25% of the units set aside for homeless individuals and the remaining 25% for persons whose income is at 60% or below the median income.

Located in New Haven, Cedar Hill is a handicapped-accessible building comprised of 25 efficiency units (2 are wheelchair adapted), that are fully furnished and each have their own kitchen and bathroom. The site boasts a common area, recreational area, garden with patio and barbecue, on site laundry, resident parking, and is convenient to CT Transit's bus line. Supportive Services are available on-site at the request of the resident.

Having opened its doors in 1996 as part of the Connecticut Supportive Housing Demonstration Program, Liberty Commons serves 40 men and women who are homeless or low-income and may struggle with mental illness and substance addiction.

Centrally located in the heart of Middletown, Liberty Commons is a five story, handicapped accessible building, comprised of forty studio apartments each with their own kitchen and bathroom. Units are furnished with beds, dressers, and chairs, air conditioned and have phone jacks already installed. There is an on-site laundry facility in addition to a recreation area, lounge and library. The site is located on CT Transit's U and D bus lines.
